Number Bibs: Number bibs are to be worn by all runners

Chute Numbers: Will be in your packets

Monitors: Will be located on the course to direct runners and check for violations

Timers: Times will be read at the 1 mile and at the 2 mile points

Awards: We will not have an awards presentation so you may leave as soon as races are complete. We will get results and medals to you.

HS Medals - Varsity 1st, 2nd and 3rd Team; 30 V Girls, 30 V Boys
JV Medals - 5 JV Girls, 5 JV Boys

MS Medals - 5 8th Girls, 5 8th Boys, 5 7th Girls, 5 7th Boys

Entry Fees - HS B, G \$50/team (\$100 total) or \$9 per runner
MS B,G \$40/team (\$80 total) or \$7 per runner

Parking - Buses will drop off runners at the Club House, then turn around and park in the East Grass Parking Lot. Fans will park in the East Grass Parking Lot

Special Considerations - Spectators will be limited to immediate family and all will be asked to social distance and wear mask when unable to be social distance

No award ceremony at end of race, results and awards will be mailed to the athletic director

Starting area and finish line will be spread out to allow room for social distancing

Fans will not be allowed to gather in team areas

This meet is using free online registration at Athletic.net!

Athletic.net is a resource for Track & Field and Cross Country coaches, offering free **statistic tracking**, easy **meet registrations**, free **meet managers**, and free tools to simplify common coaching tasks.

Follow the 4 steps below to get started:

1. Sign up for a free coach account (if you do not have one)

- Go to the website: www.athletic.net
- Click on '**Log In**' in the upper right hand corner, and then click '**Sign Up**' on the bottom of that screen.
- Complete the signup wizard
- After receiving the confirmation email, go on to #2

2. Add meets to your season calendar

- **Log In** to Athletic.net
- Navigate to the **Events page**
- Start typing **Horton Invitational 2020** into the Search Box
- Expand the meet card, and find the button to add this meet to your teams calendar
- Repeat this process for the rest of your season calendar (*You can also find meets by date and location*)
- If a meet is not listed, you can add it to your calendar by clicking 'Add new Event' and following the wizard
- Verify that your calendar is correct. Click on a Meet, then the pencil icon to make corrections to a meet, or use the trash can icon to delete a meet.

3. Enter team roster

- Navigate to your team page by opening the side menu, then click on your team.
- Click on Manage Team
- Click on Edit Roster under Athletes
- Add athletes to the roster manually, or upload your roster using the "Upload Athlete Roster" option.

4. Register athletes for Horton Invitational 2020

- Locate **Horton Invitational 2020** on your team's main Cross Country page and click on it
 - Click "**Register Athletes**"
 - Follow instructions on the meet registration page to enter your athletes into the appropriate division(s).
 - Use the "Add an athlete" buttons to add athletes to your roster if needed.
- You can freely use this meet registration feature of Athletic.net for all your meets. The host team can download them from the website for free.
